REUSING AND RECYCLING ESSENTIAL OIL BOTTLES

You've used your last drop of ritual essential oil, and you're wondering what to do with the empty bottle. Here are a few tips on how to reuse the bottle before recycling.

To prepare, remove the cap, rim, oil dropper, and label (our labels are made to be easily removed.) There are multiple ways to reuse the bottle. Before cleaning it, you can place the bottle and dropper in 1 cup of plain Epsom salt for 48-72 hours to create your own infused salt. (tip, you can do this with multiple bottles.) Place the empty bottle in a drawer or closet to freshen them up. Fill the bottle with baking soda to make an infused carpet powder (always test a small area for colorfastness.)

Once the fragrance has dissipated, soak the empty bottle in warm lightly soapy water for 20 minutes and rinse thoroughly. Use the clean bottles as a bud vase, as travel bottles for your hair or body oils, to make your own essential oil blends, or share your oils with others,

When finished, take the clean empty bottles to your local recycler or recycle them with your municipal waste.
